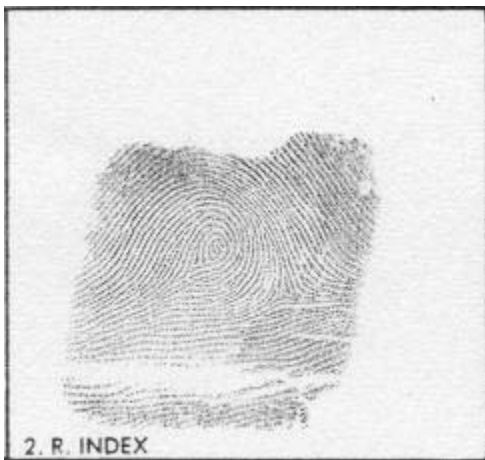


Sample Fingerprint Card for MENTOR's FBI Fingerprint Background Check Pilot

To be completed as directed:

- **Red text** should be filled in by the mentoring program and volunteer prior to being fingerprinted
- **(Blue text)** indicates fields that should be left blank
- **(Purple text)** indicates fields that should be completed at the time of fingerprinting
- **Black text** is pre-printed on the fingerprint card (you must only use MENTOR's fingerprint cards)

****Make sure that fingerprints are clearly legible and completely rolled. An example of a legible, fully rolled print is to the left.**

Legibility: You should be able to easily discern individual lines and patterns in the fingerprint. If you cannot, the fingerprints are likely to be rejected for poor quality.

Completely rolled: When printed, the finger should be rolled from side to side, and from the top down to the first joint. The fingerprint should appear rectangular if it is rolled fully, and the entire fingerprint pattern should appear.
